All players are taught to their own level of ability. Because Therapeutic Recreation has a group that plays tennis there weekly during the school year, we have been offered a discounted rate, and personalized program from the one currently being offered to the general public.

Therefore, our program will run for three weeks, Tuesdays and Thursdays, probably the last two weeks of July and the first week of August, or thereabouts, for one hour each time, probably starting at 4:00pm, at Mercy Healthplex, located on the Mercy Hospital Fairfield campus on Mack Road.

Cost is for two people to play as tennis partners - one with disabilities age 17 or older, and one age-appropriate buddy. \$120 for two players for six one-hour lessons over 3 weeks. We need a minimum of 4 pairs.






