- I. Meeting opened at 7:10 with “Prayer for Faith.”
- II. **Formation Twenty** –Holy Thursday washing of the feet was well organized by servers to help facilitate. There was no procession this year on Palm Sunday (snow).
- III. Minutes were not approved from March meeting. Many people were having trouble accessing them from the web site.
- IV. Sheri Barksdale is willing to coordinate the SL program. It was done at the 10:00 Mass on Palm Sunday. It will happen again on May 5th. She will set dates for June, July, and August. She is trying to set up a pool of interpreters to draw from. We might try the third Sunday since it is welcome Sunday.
- V. **Pastoral Associate Report:** The passport to Holy Week was a good idea for the younger children. A discussion was held as to why we need a different location for Ministers to check in.
- VI. **Continuing Business:** WC discussed the different services during Holy Week. There was an issue about the candles at the Easter Vigil. How can we correct this? The proposed solution was that we should look into investing in better candle guards.
