- II. A correction was made to the spelling of Elizabeth Conner's name. A motion was made by Pam Bange and seconded by Michelle Mort to approve the minutes. All approved.
- III. Formation Fifteen. "Music in Divine Worship" What is the role or purpose of music? It should be personal and show love of God. Music should be appropriate for the congregation.
