- b. Dress Code - How can it be enforced? Should we get ministry co-ordinators together so everyone receives the same information?
- c. Handbells - It is possible we could get people to donate and dedicate a certain bell in someone's memory. Alan motioned and Rose seconded to submit the proposal to PC and FC.
- d. PATH - Music Catechesis. Why do we do what we do? Should we invite a group of people to attend 4-5 meetings to learn why certain music is chosen? What is the role of Music?

We need a greeter co-ordinator.

Hospitality should still be listed under Worship.

- e. Sprinkling Rite. How often? Sundays of Eastertide, Sundays following Christmas, Baptism of Our Lord, Epiphany, Feast of the Holy Family.

- a. Liturgical Ministers Day. Worship needs to be in charge of Hospitality. The day will touch on 50 years since Vatican II.
- b. Worship Quadrant - Should we do a ministry fair this fall or not since we had stewardship renewal in the spring?

- d. Holy Day schedule - Should we change for the Feast of All Saints, November 1st since it is a Friday this year?
