- Tom Collins requested quarterly updates from TWG campaign and facilities.

Strategic Discussions

- 1). Plaza. Work starts Monday to be completed by end of the week.
- 2.) Debt elimination/ ground breaking
 - Last report from Archdiocese was in September. Through the end of Sept., \$1,125,000 had been collected.
 - o In June, out of \$944,000 collected, \$572,000 went to One Faith, One Hope, One Love. Remaining \$372,000 went to debt elimination.
 - Debt currently at \$122,000 to be paid off in January.
- 3). Driveways/entrances

Received information about right of first refusal for land to add secondary driveway. No fees would be associated.

- Would have to be done by archdiocese.
- o Neighboring properties currently zoned residential would have to be changed.

Campus Master Plan

- When to break ground? Many moving parts effect decision.
- Need a master plan that coordinates current structures with future planning so that building addition appears seamless. However, if design structure too soon, codes may change which would cost more \$ for architectural changes.
 - The longer we postpone construction inflation will cause costs to increase.
 Currently, construction costs up 8 10 % per year. If we take short term loan, interest rate 2-3 %. Not long term debt because loan would be paid off as pledge payments come in.
 - o Probably 8 month lead time from decision to start until ground breaking.
 - Start with master plan and architect's plans around Jan 1. Estimate cost at \$180,000. Consensus- 3 neutral, remainder yes.

Committee Updates

- CMA Ad Hoc Committee (Jerry Pater)
 - Committee will look at how monies are collected and distributed consolidating processes
 - Outreach commission has changed to soliciting applications to distribute \$.
 - \$385,000 distributed over last 4 years.

Campus Safety Subcommittee (MaryAnn Ridenour and Larry Witsken)

- Larry and Stephanie are putting together information for flip books of emergency procedures. Books should be done in Feb.
- Next step is training.
