My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the Gospel of St. John, Mary Magdalene is the first witness to the Resurrection. Upon discovering the empty tomb she hurries off to report this mysterious event to the Apostles. She says to them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we do not know where they put Him." (Jn 20:2)

In response, Peter and John go racing off to the tomb only to discover the same sight that Mary Magdalene saw, an empty tomb.

In that moment, on that first Easter, none of the Apostles or Mary Magdalene understood exactly what they were seeing, or not seeing for that matter. St. John explains that this was so because "they did not yet understand the Scripture that [Jesus] had to rise from the dead." (Jn 20:9) Eventually they would understand and consequently spend the rest of their lives sharing that glorious news that our Lord is risen! Death is conquered! Salvation has been won for us!

In time that good news would flow forth from the silence of the empty tomb, resounding throughout the world. It is the good news that will be proclaimed and exclaimed in our parish church on this Easter Sunday, April 21, 2019.

The task that lies before us is clear. We have received the joyful news. The temptation might be to simply receive that news and then do nothing more. However, like Mary, John and Peter on that Easter morn, we are to make haste, to go out into the world and share the glorious truth of the Resurrection.
