St Gabriel Possenti: blasted a lizard from 20 feet away with a handgun, showing his marksmanship and scaring away invaders who were terrorizing the town.



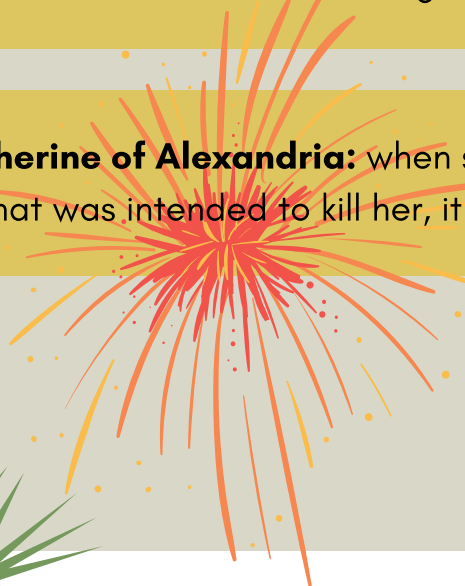
St. Boniface: saw the people in town worshipping a tree, and in his anger chopped the tree down with one swing of an axe.
